World Mission Rosary Dream Catcher

Materials Needed:

- Paper plate
- Colored ribbons
- Hole puncher
- Craft beads
- Scissors
- Religious symbols printed on cardstock
- Markers (if using a white plate)
- Tape

Instructions:

- 1. Cut out the center of the plate. Leave a rim of 2 inches all around the paper plate.
- 2. Punch holes in the rim of the plate about 1 1/2 inches apart.
- 3. Cut ribbon into strips about 15 inches long. Tie one end of a piece of ribbon behind any hole. Thread a few colored beads onto the ribbon. Pass the ribbon through another hole and thread more beads onto the ribbon. Tie off ribbon on back of plate. Repeat weaving ribbon until all holes have been threaded with beaded ribbon. Tape down ribbon ends on back of plate.
- 4. Thread ribbon through top hole to hand dream catcher
- 5. Thread ribbons through three bottom hole and hang religious symbols (templates attached) on the ends of the ribbons. We taped ours on.
- 6. If a white plate was used, decorate the edges with markers.
- 7. Think of something a child in the missions may dream for and pray for that dream to come true!
