

World Mission Rosary in Plastic Cups



Materials Needed:

- 26 White plastic cups
- 12 Blue plastic cups
- 12 Red plastic cups
- 11 Yellow plastic cups
- 11 Green plastic cups
- Chain link fence



We used 16 ounce cups for our fence. Your size may differ.

- 1. Insert cups through fence so that the bottom of the cup is facing the viewer. The cups can be squeezed a little bit for ease of insertion—not too much or they may crack!
- 2. Use eleven white cups to form the cross, then one of each color for the first Our Father and three Hail Marys.
- 3. Use four white cups to form a square "medal".
- 4. Insert ten green cups for the Hail Marys for Africa, leave a space, then use a green cup for an Our Father.
- 5. Repeat this pattern with red cups for the Americas, white cups for Europe, and blue cups for Oceania.
- 6. Finish with ten yellow cups for the Hail Marys for Asia.
- 7. Gather your students to pray for the missions!
